For each NTI day, please complete 1 activity from EACH chart (READING, MATH, SOCIAL STUDIES/SCIENCE and ENRICHMENT). All activities can be turned in when we return to school. You will need to choose a different activity for each day from each section. Please shade each box as you complete the activities. You should plan to spend a total of 1-2 hours working during each NTI day.

ELA

Read a book and then draw and label a character from the book.	Read to someone (sibling, animal, adult) and have someone read to you.	Read a story and then draw pictures of the main events of the story in order.	Cut out sight words or letters to create sight words from magazines and newspapers.
Write about building a snowman.	Cut out environmental print from magazines or newspapers. (labels of known products/ places- <i>ex: Legos, McDonald's, Walmart, etc.</i>)	Starfall Reading website	Read a story. Write about and draw your favorite part.

MATH

Use playdough, toothpicks and marshmallows to practice making 3-D shapes (cone, cube, cylinder, sphere).	Grab a handful of Cheerios (or other item for counting). Count how many you grabbed. Have a parent grab a handful-Who grabbed more or less? Why?	Draw 4 different sizes of snowmen. Cut them out and arrange them from smallest to biggest, and then biggest to smallest.	Help a grown up with the laundry and sort the clothes by the type of clothing or by color.
Practice writing numbers to 20-forwards and backwards.	Build lego towers using different patterns. Tell your parents or friends about the different patterns you used.	Count out loud to 100. Every time you time say one of the decade numbers (10,20,30, etc.), jump!	Find as many flat or solid shapes around your house and then draw a picture.

Social Studies/Science

Make two snowballs. Pour salt on one of the snowballs; see which snowball melts the fastest. Draw a picture of your observation.	Find items that you can push and pull around the house. Draw a picture to show what you pushed and pulled.	Play with ramps to make toy cars go fast or slow. Find ways to stop items at the bottom of the ramp or change direction.	Draw a picture of today's weather. Include details about the clouds, ground, animals spotted and temperature.
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Draw a map of your bedroom. Include windows and doors in your map.	Draw a picture of the American flag. Then, create your own flag to represent yourself. Include favorite colors, pictures on your flag.	Draw and write about your favorite holiday. Include traditions you have with your family.	Create a timeline of your life from birth to Kindergarten.
