ELA

Read for 30 minutes.	Write a story with a beginning, middle, and end.	Draw a picture and write about the best part of this day. Share it with someone.	Work on Lexia for 30 minutes.
Work in vocabulary on Moby Max for 30 minutes.	Write sight words from the sight word list using pencil, marker, or crayons.	Read for 30 minutes.	Write a story about playing in the snow and circle the nouns and underline the verbs.

MATH

Work on Moby Max for 30 minutes.	Count out up to 120 pieces of cereal, pasta, cubes, or other small objects.	Write numbers from 0-120 with crayons, pencil, pen, or markers.	Draw a picture using shapes (triangle, square, rectangle, circle, and half-circles). Label the shapes.
Compare the length of 3 similar objects put them in order by size (shortest-longest).	Measure the length of an object by using several shorter objects (This bear is 40 legos long.).	Organize 3 categories of toys (example: dolls, cars, games) or household items (forks, spoons, plates). Ask questions (example: How many more ___ than ___? Which group has more/less? How do you know? etc.)	Practice addition and subtraction facts from 1-20

Social Studies/Science

Create a musical instrument using items in your home.	Conduct an investigation to see which items light travels through (possible items; cardboard, t-shirt, dinner plate, plastic wrap, and wax paper).	Observe and record how the sun moves across the sky from the time you get up until it gets dark.	Measure the snow in the sun and the shade in the morning and then again in the afternoon. Are they the same or different? Why?
Create a list of rules for an imaginary classroom.	Create a plan for how your family should spend \$100.	Talk to a person older than you (parent or grandparents age) about what school, technology, toys, and transportation were like when they were your age.	Draw a picture of 5 goods (things we buy) and 5 services (what people do for us) in our community.

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
