DEVICE ACCIDENTAL PROTECTION PLAN

The Franklin County Public School system is providing and administering an insurance program for students and parents as part of our 1:World project. Enrollment in this program is mandatory for a student to be issued a device. Enrollment in the program is achieved by completing this form and submitting it to Franklin County Public Schools. This plan covers “accidental damage” to the device and is designed to limit a family’s financial responsibility for any damages as described in the coverage section below. In addition, each device is covered under a manufacturer warranty that covers the normal operation of the device to ensure that it functions properly.
